

RECRUITING ADULTS WITH LONG COVID (AwLC), CAREGIVERS OF AwLC, AND HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS OF AwLC FOR A RESEARCH STUDY

Study Title: Enhancing the Person and Family Centered Nature of Long COVID Care for Adults

Qualitative interviews will explore participants' thoughts about family centred care for long COVID and how this type of care can be better organized throughout the different stages of treatment.

What the study involves:

- A 1-hour telephone/video conference interview exploring development of patient care plans in the context of families, collaboration between families and health care professionals, family contexts that influence care, procedures and policies to support families, educational needs, and strategies to coordinate care across the care continuum.

Eligibility criteria:

<u>Adults with long COVID:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 18+ years old● Meets WHO (2022) definition of long COVID	<u>Caregivers of AwLC:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Family, friends, or neighbours● 2+ months of caregiving experience● Provide daily activity support at least once a week
<u>Healthcare Providers (HCPs) of AwLC:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 2+ months of experience with AwLC● At least 25% of caseload focused on AwLC	<u>General Requirements:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Able to participate in interviews and communicate in English● Located in Canada
